



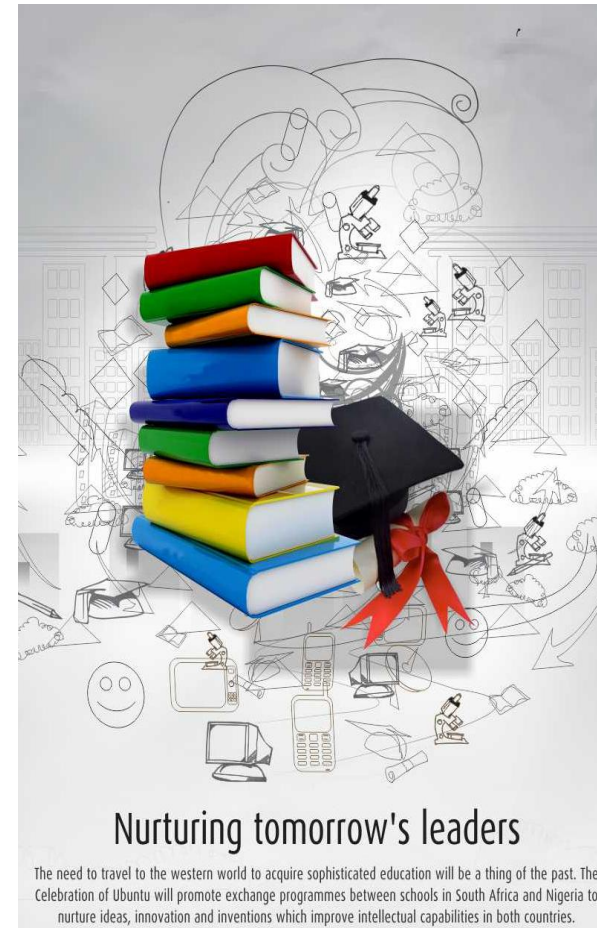

THEMES / TOPICS

Themes to be explored must be relevant to empowering women. Scope is unlimited but must reveal contemporary challenges society face.

POSITION

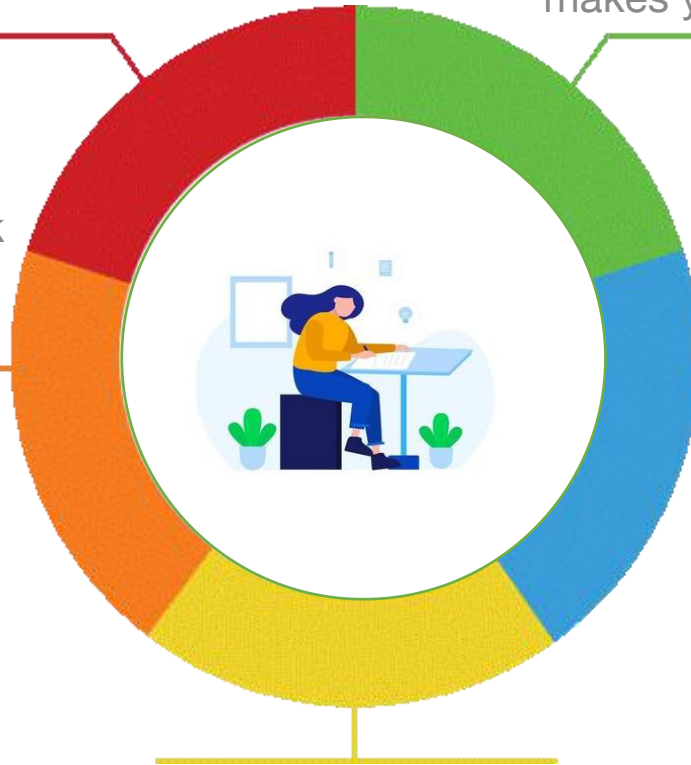
Understand the gender perspective market, and how your book can support education, enterprise, policy making and general reading pleasure. What makes your book unique.

AUDIENCE

It is important to know the primary audience the book is addressing. It's a plus if the core audience is youth

STRUCTURE

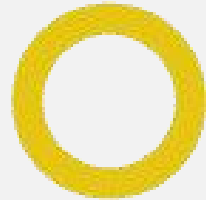
The submission should not exceed 3 A4 pages, with basic information on author. Submit in Word with simple formatting.



CRITICAL THINKING

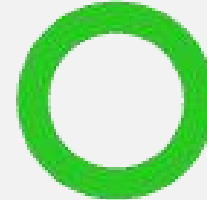
The book proposal must show creativity in analyzing topical and traditional norms with the mind to reconstruct society by empowering women.

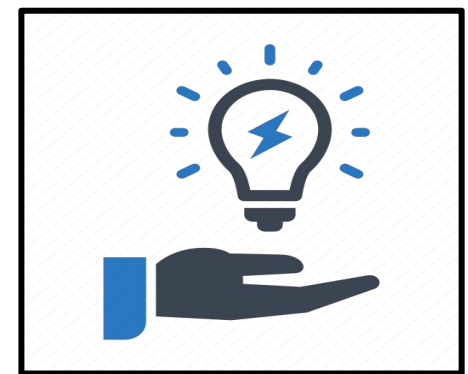
Essential features of your Book Proposal

- Header ... include title, author name, email etc
- Synopsis. No more than six paragraphs - must be an elevator pitch and succinct description of book.
- Chapter breakdown (this can change during writing and shouldn't bother you, but important in planning).
- Book details ... will it include images, illustrations, is it a graphic novel? What is your projected word count?
- About the author / biography
